Anti-gun Lobby Admits Laws Are No Solution To Violence

The International Coalition for Women in Shooting and Hunting (WiSH) have congratulated the Coalition for Gun Control for admitting that gun laws offer no solution to gang-related violence in Toronto.

“After years of mistakenly insisting that ever-increasing gun laws reduce violence in society, it is positive to see gun prohibitionists finally realise what the public have known for years,” said WiSH Chair Dr Samara McPhedran.

“Focussing on firearms wasted billions of taxpayer dollars that could have gone towards tackling inequality and social disadvantage, and troubled young people have suffered as a result.”

“Youth crime and its underlying causes, such as substance dependence, must be addressed through careful policies based on evidence.”

“We hope gun prohibitionists’ newfound concern for youth will be accompanied by a sense of responsibility towards the community that places social wellbeing ahead of ideology.”
