Gun Prohibition Reaction to US Shooting Reveals Fringe Element

The International Coalition for Women in Shooting and Hunting (WiSH) has dismissed calls by fringe elements of the anti-gun lobby for more gun bans in Australia following the saddening SuccessTech Academy shootings in the United States.

WiSH Chair Dr Samara McPhedran said "As always, there are extremists within Australia whose instant response to a shooting in the US is a confused demand for still more gun bans in Australia."

"It is especially disappointing that the anti-gun lobby do not wait for accurate information to emerge, and are more interested in grabbing media headlines in Australia than in extending sympathy to shocked families in the United States."

"Time and time again we see this reaction, and time and time again gun prohibitionists simply demonstrate that they are geographically embarrassed, and do not understand current Australian firearms legislation," said Dr McPhedran.
