Gun Prohibitionists' Flawed Position Revealed

Anti-gun lobbyists' demands for more gun bans have come unravelled with the revelation that yesterday's tragic shooting in Melbourne was committed by an offender alleged to have a long criminal history, say the International Coalition for Women in Shooting and Hunting (WiSH).

WiSH Chair Dr Samara McPhedran said "Gun prohibitionists' first reaction to this awful event was to zealously push for more laws restricting legal firearms ownership. Their poor judgement and blinkered ideological views are now laid bare as it emerges that legal ownership played no role."

"The Federal Minister for Justice and Customs, among others, responded appropriately by stating that criminal abuse of firearms is where attention should be directed, and bans and taxpayer-funded buybacks are not the way to achieve this."

"It seems gun prohibitionists are the only ones who still believe senseless crimes can be prevented by placing bureaucratic burdens on legal firearms owners," Dr McPhedran said.
